



Camp Boggy Creek Fact Sheet

- Established:** 1990 at a cost of \$23 million
- Facility:** 232 acres, 44 buildings including 16 camper cabins, dining hall, medical center, swim center, stable and little farm, sports and recreation center, arts and crafts center, creative arts center and theater.
- Sessions:** 9 one-week summer sessions, 20 family weekends.
- Campers:** Since camp opened in 1996, more than 40,000 campers and their families have been served.
- Volunteers:** Over 2,000 volunteers lend their talents to camp each year.
- Population:** Children ages 7-16 with one of the following diseases or illnesses: Asthma, Bleeding Disorders and Hemophilia, Cancer, Craniofacial Disorders, Diabetes, Epilepsy, Heart/Cardiovascular, HIV/AIDS, Inflammatory Bowel Disease, Kidney Disease, Rheumatic Disease, Ventilator Assisted Disorders, Sickle Cell Anemia, Spina Bifida and Transplants
- Cost:** Campers and their family members do not pay to attend Camp Boggy Creek. Camp Boggy Creek is solely supported by contributions and donations from individuals, corporations and foundations. The estimated cost for campers is \$2,877 per camper for a summer session and \$69,120 for a family weekend session.
- Activities:** swimming, boating, fishing, arts & crafts, horseback riding, theater, archery, singing, dancing, sports and recreation.
