The mission of Camp Boggy Creek is to enrich the lives of children who have chronic or life threatening illnesses by creating camping experiences that are memorable, exciting, fun, empowering, physically safe and medically sound.



Please make a note of these important facts regarding your event to benefit Camp Boggy Creek

1. You will receive an official letter from Camp Boggy Creek for use of our logo and name prior to your event once the agreement and proposal are submitted and reviewed.
2. The event should be consistent with Camp Boggy Creek's brand image.
3. Camp Boggy Creek should be identified as the *beneficiary* of the event, not the sponsor. If you are sharing your proceeds with Camp Boggy Creek and other charities, you will outline this on the proposal page and additionally include that information in any advertising or public information regarding your event.
4. All fundraising must comply with federal, state, and local laws governing charitable fundraising. Please check with local authorities to determine unique requirements for each type of event, before submitting your proposal.
5. The following disclosure is required for all fundraisers in the state of Florida. This disclaimer must appear in ALL CAPS and exactly as written:

"A COPY OF THE OFFICIAL REGISTRATION AND FINANCIAL INFORMATION MAY BE OBTAINED FROM THE DIVISION OF CONSUMER SERVICES BY CALLING TOLL FREE 1-800-435-7352 WITHIN THE STATE. REGISTRATION DOES NOT IMPLY ENDORSEMENT, APPROVAL OR RECOMMENDATION BY THE STATE. THE BOGGY CREEK GANG, INC.'S REGISTRATION NUMBER IS CH991. ONE HUNDRED PERCENT OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS RECEIVED ARE FOR THE BENEFIT OF CAMP BOGGY CREEK"

The last sentence of this statement reflects the fact that Camp Boggy Creek does not use the services of professional solicitors or fundraisers to secure donations. We do not pay others to raise funds for us.

6. You understand that under the law you must purchase any items for you event and pay the tax. You **may not** use Camp Boggy Creek's non profit status for purchases for your event. You **may not** open any accounts, banking or commercial, in the name of Camp Boggy Creek.
7. You understand that anyone providing you and your club or organization with funding will not receive any receipt from Camp Boggy Creek for Tax deductions unless they directly write a check to Camp Boggy Creek as a donation with nothing in return. We will provide thank you letters to sponsors or in-kind donors once you provide us with the names and addresses.
8. Annual events will register each year for approval.
9. Proceeds for Camp Boggy Creek will be mailed or delivered within two weeks of the closing date of your event.

Camp Boggy Creek Fast Facts

Terminology:

Children attending Camp Boggy Creek suffer from “**chronic or serious illness.**” We kindly ask that you do not use the phrases “terminally ill” or “terminal illness” when referring to the children who attend Camp Boggy Creek. This includes all promotional materials and media pieces.

Boggy Blurb:

Our camp is specifically designed for children with chronic or life threatening illnesses and allows them to safely enjoy the activities of a "traditional" camp. Between early morning swims and evening campfires, children whose lives have been a series of medical procedures and hospital stays are transformed into just "kids." They have a chance to be with others coping with the same illness or condition and realize that they are not alone.

General Information:

- ♥ Facility: 232 acres, 44 buildings including 16 camper cabins, dining hall, medical center, swim center, stable and little farm, sports and recreation center, arts and crafts center, creative arts center and theater.
- ♥ Sessions: 9 one-week summer sessions, 20 family weekends.
- ♥ Campers: more than 40,000 campers and their families have been served.
- ♥ Volunteers: Over 2,000 volunteers lend their talents to camp each year.
- ♥ Population: Children ages 7-16 with one of the following diseases or illnesses: Asthma, Bleeding, Disorders, Hemophilia, Cancer, Craniofacial Disorders, Diabetes, Epilepsy, Heart/Cardiovascular, HIV/AIDS, Inflammatory Bowel Disease, Kidney Disease, Rheumatic Disease, Ventilator Assisted Disorders, Sickle Cell Anemia, Spina Bifida and Transplants
- ♥ Boggy Creek is solely supported by contributions and donations from individuals, corporations and foundations. The estimated cost for campers is \$2,877 per camper for a summer session and \$69,120 for a family weekend session.
- ♥ Activities: swimming, boating, fishing, arts & crafts, horseback riding, theater, archery, singing, dancing, sports and recreation.
