



## *There is no other place like Boggy Creek ...*

Our camp is the only multi-disease therapeutic program in Florida that provides medically supervised recreational activities for children with chronic or life-threatening illnesses. Working with medical partners throughout the state to identify seriously ill children, we offer free camperships to children ages 7 through 16 who suffer from:

- Asthma • Cancer and Blood-related Disorders • Craniofacial Differences
- Diabetes • Epilepsy
- Heart/Cardiovascular Disease
- Hemophilia • HIV/AIDS
- Kidney Disease • Rheumatic Disease
- Sickle Cell Anemia • Spina Bifida
- Transplants • Disorders Requiring Ventilator Assistance

Since opening our doors in 1996, more than 40,000 chronically ill children and family members have experienced the magic of Boggy Creek, all at no cost to the children or their families.
