

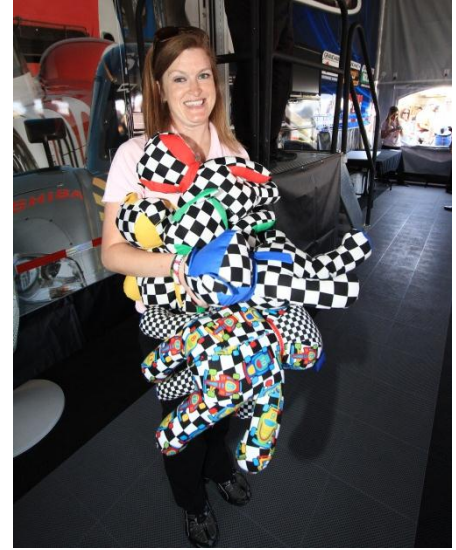
## Camp Boggy Creek – A Proud Charity of IMSA
